Harlan FFA Chapter Celebrates 2023 National FFA Week

The Harlan Community School District's FFA Chapter celebrated National FFA Week, February 18-25, 2023. More than 850,000 members participated in National FFA Week activities at local, state and national levels.

Designated as National FFA Week in 1947, the week of George Washington's birthday is FFA Week, and runs from Saturday to Saturday. FFA Week gives FFA members an opportunity to educate the public about agriculture. During the week, chapters across the nation conduct a variety of activities to help others in their school and community learn about FFA and agricultural education. Harlan FFA celebrated National FFA Week by participating in various activities throughout the week. A coloring contest was held for all PK-5th grade students, with prizes being awarded to each grade level. Members hosted a faculty appreciation breakfast at the high school during the week. Other fun activities were school dress up days themed towards agriculture or FFA, FFA trivia activities, and an FFA Emblem scavenger hunt.

Today, FFA provides the next generation of leaders who will change the world. As the top school-based youth lead-

ership development organization in the nation, FFA helps young people meet new agricultural challenges by developing their unique talents and exploring their interests in a broad range of career pathways. FFA members are our future leaders, our future food suppliers, our future innovators and more!

The National FFA Organization is a school-based national youth leadership development organization of more than 850,000 student members as part of 8,995 local FFA chapters in all 50 states, Puerto Rico, and the Virgin Islands.

Harlan FFA stands strong at 180 middle school, high school, and college members. The FFA Mission states: "FFA makes a positive difference in the lives of students by developing their potential for premier leadership, personal growth and career success through agricultural education." Harlan FFA members' "Premier leadership" is built through participating in FFA Leadership Career Development Events. Students work on their "personal growth and career success" through their Supervised Agricultural Experience Projects and participation in Ag Skills Career

Development Events. Students' entrepreneurship projects include market and breeding beef, swine, sheep, horse, rabbits, and chickens. Placement projects include working on farms and at local agricultural businesses. Students in the agriculture program at Harlan Community Schools have the opportunity to learn real world connections by working with area businesses and hands on learning opportunities in the classroom, shop or greenhouse.

Annual community development activities include conducting the Food for America Program, a service project conducted by the FFA seniors to teach elementary students various agriculture related topics. FFA also assists with various service projects around the Harlan Community including cancer awareness fundraisers, food drives and promoting agriculture safety and advocacy. Members hold the values of the FFA Creed, "I believe that American agriculture can and will hold true to the best traditions of our national life and that I can exert an influence in my home and community which will stand solid for my part in that inspiring task."


